Description

The project phase is coming to an end. You worked hard on your plugins and improved them over many weeks. The next weeks will be about finalising and documenting your plugin.

Tasks

1. Beta Plugin

The Beta Plugin is about the following:

1. Improving your Alpha Plugin
2. Creating a good and natural user experience

Hints

- You can talk and **test** with the other groups to get feedback on your plugin

2. Documentation

To ensure that your plugin is installable and understandable a detailed documentation is necessary. The documentation consists out of the following parts:

1. A detailed step-by-step installation guide to get it running
2. Information on the limitations and design choices
3. Code documentation
4. A hero shot

Format

All files need to be packed into a ZIP file. Submit this as a group solution in RWTHMoodle. The ZIP archive contains the following content:

- Matriculation number of **each** group member
- A PDF (12pt font size) named **manual.pdf** containing detailed information about your plugin including:
 - Installation (macOS **and** Windows)
 - Usage
 - Limitations
 - Working procedure (how your plugin works)
 - A description of your plugin (max. 5 sentences)
- A hero shot named **heroshot.png**
- The Beta Plugin including all necessary files

Make sure that the Beta Plugin is on **GitLab** as well.

Hints

- Look at the projects from the [Multimodal Media Madness 2020](#) to get some inspiration on the hero shot and the description
- Include pictures in your documentation

Grading

Both the work in the group and the careful handling of the tasks in the lab are a prerequisite for a successful passing of the course.

Points are given for the assignment and the amount of work involved is included in the grading of the final project.

It is advisable to make clear for some assignments which team members have worked on the respective subtasks. At the end of the project, however, each member should be able to answer questions about each topic.

Assignments handed in after the deadline will be considered negative in the final evaluation.
